

California's Proposition 65

California's Proposition 65 entitles California individuals to special warnings for products that contain chemicals known to the state of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm if those products expose consumers to such chemicals above certain threshold levels.

This document certifies that to the best of our current knowledge and belief and under normal usage, VersaLogic's printed circuit board assemblies and accessory products are in compliance with California Proposition 65 (The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, 1986). Although a small number of our products contain lead there is no exposure route, such as contact with food/drink or inhalation. VersaLogic's products contain No Significant Risk Levels (NSRLs) for cancer-causing chemicals and are below the Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADLs) for chemicals causing reproductive toxicity. Therefore, a warning label that our product contains compounds that may cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm is not required.



However, during destructive decomposition, our products may contain and release trace amounts of lead (Pb), Arsenic (As), Beryllium (Be); Nickel (Ni); substances listed as chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and/or birth defects or other reproductive harm. To reduce risk of exposure, work with approved safety equipment in a well-ventilated
