

**Issue:**

The VL-MPEu-G2 will not operate with VersaLogic's standard Linux release (Debian Squeeze).

**Solution:**

Debian Wheezy should be used instead. To use the VL-MPEu-G2 with Debian Wheezy, follow the procedure below:

1. Download the libgps20 3.6-4 and gpsd 3.6-4 packages from [packages.debian.org](http://packages.debian.org):

- o <http://packages.debian.org/wheezy/libgps20>
- o <http://packages.debian.org/wheezy/gpsd>

2. Install the packages in the order above using the command:

```
dpkg -i <packagename>
```

3. After installing the gpsd package, configure it using the command:

```
dpkg-reconfigure -plow gpsd
```

4. Respond to the prompts as follows:

- a. Start gpsd automatically?: no
- b. Should gpsd handle attached USB GPS receivers automatically: yes
- c. Device the GPS receiver is attached to: /dev/ttyACM0
- d. Accept the defaults for all other prompts.

5. Installing these packages enables basic functionality. Other programs that provide mapping functionality (such as FoxtrotGPS) can be found on [packages.debian.org](http://packages.debian.org).
